

S3 Table. Definition of dose-limiting toxicities

Category	Criteria for determining a dose-limiting toxicity (DLT)
Hematological toxicity	Grade 4 neutropenia (ANC < 500/ μ L) lasting \geq 7 days Febrile neutropenia of grade 3 or higher Neutropenia of grade 3 or higher, accompanying infection Thrombocytopenia of grade 4 (platelet < 25,000/ μ L) Grade 3 thrombocytopenia (platelet < 50,000/ μ L) lasting \geq 7 days, accompanying bleeding, or requiring platelet transfusion
Non-hematological toxicity	Any adverse event of grade 3 or higher, except alopecia Uncontrollable nausea or vomiting of grade 3 or higher Unmanageable diarrhea of grade 3 or higher Unmanageable skin rash of grade 3 or higher
Other	Any unresolved toxicity causing a delay in the administration of GC1118 three times in a row Any unresolved toxicity causing a delay in the administration of FOLFIRI for two weeks or longer

Any of the conditions listed in each category was reported as a DLT. ANC, absolute neutrophil count; FOLFIRI, 5-fluorouracil, leucovorin, and irinotecan.
