A circular cladogram presents the identified taxa distributed according to phylogenetic characteristics around the circle. The dots in the center and the outer circle present the taxa at the kingdom and species levels, respectively. The color of the dots and regions indicate the respective taxa enriched in CRC cases and controls. The size of the dots represents the level of significance according to the $-\log_{10}$ p-value.
